Area of Maths: Multiplication and Division

Objective: Multiply two-digit and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number using formal written layout.

YOU WILL NEED...

Resources:

There are downloadable resources available to accompany this lesson.

Equipment:

You will need a hoop/container to hold the number cards, pens/pencils and paper.



Instructions:

- 1. Children are divided into teams and seated around the outside of the hall/area (in a larger circle).
- 2. A hoop/basket is placed in the middle of the hall (this is the number generator).
- 3. On command of 'Go' each team sends one child to the number generator who will collect one number/card.
- 4. Once the team have been to the number generator 3 times they will have 3 numbers (easily differentiated).
- 5. Once they have 3 numbers they must make a multiplication calculation.
 - e.g. 13 x 5 and use written methods to work out the answer on the card/paper provided.
- 6. How many can you do in 12 minutes?
