

Area of Maths: Multiplication and Division

Objective: Multiply two-digit and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number using formal written layout.

YOU WILL NEED...

Resources:

There are downloadable resources available to accompany this lesson.

Equipment:

You will need a hoop/container to hold the number cards, pens/pencils and paper.



Instructions:

1. Children are divided into teams and seated around the outside of the hall/area (in a larger circle).
2. A hoop/basket is placed in the middle of the hall (this is the number generator).
3. On command of 'Go' each team sends one child to the number generator who will collect one number/ card.
4. Once the team have been to the number generator 3 times they will have 3 numbers (easily differentiated).
5. Once they have 3 numbers they must make a multiplication calculation.
e.g. 13×5 and use written methods to work out the answer on the card/paper provided.
6. How many can you do in 12 minutes?
