Area of Maths: Addition and Subtraction

**Objective:** Estimate and use inverse operations to check answers to a calculation.

## YOU WILL NEED...

## Resources:

There are downloadable resources available to accompany this lesson.

## **Equipment:**

You will need a large hoop (optional).



## Instructions:

1. Teams run and collect a sum card from a designated area e.g. a hoop full of numbers at the end of the hall.

Note: A sum card will show a sum – it will show two numbers and an answer. The answer is based on the two numbers being added to/subtracted from one another.

- 2. If the children feel the numbers have been added/subtracted correctly and that the answer is correct, then the card goes into the True pile.
- 3. If, however, they see something which is wrong, then it simply goes into the False pile.
- 4. Once completed, get pairs to look at each other's piles. Are they the same or different? Promote explanation and reasoning.
- 5. Finally, the teacher can reveal the correct answers and cover any misconceptions.
