Scaled scores are an interpretation of the children's results. A score of 100 represents the average level of attainment and/or Age Related Expectations (ARE) for the cohort.

A score of 110 and over represents high level attainment in reading, writing and maths. The table above shows children who achieved this score. In the absence of a current national average figure, we have compared this data with the Hertfordshire average which is typically above the national average.

Progress

The DFE have defined a score of '0' in all subjects as a national average. The progress scale is from -10 to 10 though as an example 50% of schools in reading will fall between -1.8 and 2.8. In writing, 50% will fall between -4.6 and -0.2 and in maths, the relative figure is -1.9 and 2.3. It is important to understand that negative scores do not mean that the children have not made progress but rather in comparison to other schools nationally, they made less progress.
