Our School Crossing Patrols have been very keen to return to work since some easing of restrictions was announced, allowing our primary schools to re-open from 1st June.

More than 90% of Hertfordshire primary schools have reopened their doors since the announcement, welcoming children from key groups and with much needed help from our patrols in keeping people safe whilst travelling to school, 98 of crossings are now in full operation.

To assist our patrols some sites have had temporary modifications to allow for children to walk, scoot or cycle to school, whilst incorporating social distancing.

Feedback from school staff, parents and residents has been very positive and for children it has been comforting to see the welcoming sight of their friendly patrol waiting to assist them across the road safely.
