Area of Maths: Number 40 - 60+ months

Skill: Counts objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10.


YOU WILL NEED...

Resources:

There are downloadable resources available to accompany this lesson.

Equipment:

You will require a number of cones for this activity.



Instructions:

- 1. Teacher puts out 10 cones (or possibly more) and 'count and respond' signs for the cones.
- 2. Children have to run around to each cone and count the dots on the signs.
- 3. They must then complete the challenge that number of times at the cone before moving on.
- 4. The winners are the ones that complete all the challenges the correct number of times first.

Differentiation:

- Teacher may want to read and explain the challenges to the children first.
- The number of dots on the resource card could be changed so children are counting beyond 10 on some more activities.
- Assistance given to the children if required.

Links To Other Areas Of EYFS:

- C&L 40-60+: Responds to instructions involving a two-part sequence.
- PD 40-60+: Practices some appropriate safety measures without direct supervision.

Links To Characteristics Of Effective Learning:

- Playing and Exploring; engagement: Seeking challenge. Showing a 'can do' attitude. Taking a risk, engaging in new experiences, and learning by trial and error.
- Active Learning motivation: Persisting with activity when challenges occur. Showing a belief that more
