He was truly transformed from a cruel persecutor of Christians into someone who told everyone about the love of Jesus, and wrote nearly half of our New Testament Bible.





We used the images of beautiful butterflies to help us think about how the power of God can transform *everyone* into new creations, making a group wild weaving of a butterfly, and creating beautiful butterfly paintings in our outdoor classroom.
