Children will consolidate sentence structure and punctuation by looking at the poem The spider and the Fly. They will look at the traditional tales of The Tortoise and the Hare and The Kapock Tree, and write their own fable and newspaper reports. They will also look at research and note taking to organise and write a report.	Children will consolidate the place value and regrouping knowledge from previous years. They will extend their counting on and back in ones, tens and hundreds to three-digit numbers. They will investigate estimation and rounding, measures and consolidate addition and subtraction inverse fact families.
