<p>Children will write up a balanced discussion presenting two sides of an argument, following a debate.</p> <p>They will show through a range of writing an understanding of how persuasive writing can be adapted for different audiences and purposes.</p>	<p>Children will add and subtract using formal written methods. They will use formal written method for multiplication and a formal written method of short division.</p> <p>Children will then find equivalent fractions and compare and order fractions before adding and subtracting fractions.</p>	<p>Children will explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object. They will identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces and carry out experiments to deepen understanding.</p>	<p>Children will deepen their prior learning about incarnation. They will then discuss whether Jesus really was the messiah and study stories suggesting he was.</p>
