

School Meal Charges

If you choose for your child to have a school prepared meal you must ensure their Arbor meal account is in credit so all meals are paid for in advance. If meal accounts fall in arrears, we will have no choice but to put the account on hold and we will request that a packed lunch is provided from home.

Free School Meals

If you are having difficulty paying for school meals and are in receipt of benefits you may be entitled to Free School Meals, funded by the government. If eligible your child will also receive Pupil Premium funding which is used to improve the education provision and to provide additional resources for your child and the school community.

Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 can only receive Free School Meals once your application has been approved. Until such time any school meals taken will need to be paid for. Checks are then carried out routinely to confirm which children remain eligible.
